My Beloved People.

I don't know if I've ever been more satisfied in my life. I share this with you because I want to testify to the goodness of God. The stuff around me is the same, God is the same, but what is different is that the abstract teachings of Christ are becoming manifested in my emotions (I never knew that was possible). For example, I share with you often that the moral character (whether an action is good or bad) is not determined by the fruit (outcome) of an action but by the intention of the person who does the action. God desires to change how we see good and evil; so that we may become new creatures. This past week I was backing out of my sister's driveway and collided with a tree. I got out of the truck and noticed that my bumper was catawampus and a huge dent was in the rear guarter panel. I was surprised that I was not upset. I noticed that I was smiling and that the damage was not affecting me at all. Later that day I was spiritually journaling and made the connection that because my intention that morning was pure (I had not chosen selfishly, nor sinfully) why should I feel 'bad' about the negative fruit of my accident. In the our cultures eyes success is about the fruit: A successful company is defined by how profitable they are, not if they intend to do good. A football team is 'good' if they win the game. Are you willing to allow God to renovate how you see 'good' and 'bad?' (Trust me, if you do, Life becomes so much more satisfying because all you have to worry about is pleasing Him.)

Two weeks till Easter! Keep striving to accomplish your Fasting, Prayer, and Study for Lent; and, if you have failed, that's okay: just start over! Have blessed week and let us prepare our hearts to welcome Christ next weekend on Palm Sunday, shouting "Hosanna, Hosanna, in the Highest!"
