As we enter the 2<sup>nd</sup> Week of Advent, Holy Mother Church exhorts us to grow in Joyful Expectation. Unfortunately, Joy doesn't come about magically. You can't simply flick the light switch and have Joy running throughout your home. Joy is a fruit. It comes about as a result of doing the good. I am not too good at cleaning. Although games are not sinful, it isolated me from my duties, responsibilities, and others... and it left me with no Joy! The Lord is coming, let us prepare ourselves to go out to meet Him!
