Blessing of Jordan water, chalk and incense: Although there are fine texts for the blessing of homes, it reminds us of the dust of the earth from which we were made, and “Jordan water.” The chalk is used to mark **20 + C + M + B + 26** over door ways. The numerals consecrate the new year. The initials remind us of the legendary names of the magi –Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar—and also stand for the Latin motto *Christus mansionem benedicat* (“May Christ bless the house”). After Mass some parishes have a “visit” from the magi, who bless the main doors of the church in the customary way and then distribute the chalk and water as well as grains of incense—and some instructions, as necessary, about the custom.
