My Good People,

One of the effects of Secularist Humanism (the dominate philosophical thought of our current society) is that it annihilates subtlety/nuance and, in its place, demands polarized thinking. We see it on the news each night. One group is strongly opposed and another group is strongly in favor of such and such. But this isn't the case with reality because this is not the case with God and His creation. For example, I like to entertain (not to often, but a few times a year). There are two dishes that I include on nearly every menu. For dessert I prefer to serve a frozen custard. It is a dish my grandfather made and it is simple: cream, egg yolks, sugar, and vanilla. It is delicious. For a cold appetizer I prefer to serve a personal take on Shrimp Remoulade with Artichokes and Leeks. It takes a day and half to make and has 42 ingredients. It is also delicious. Somethings and sometimes in life things are easy and sometimes they are more complex. Sometimes it's easy to forgive, sometimes it's complex. Sometimes it's easy to pray, sometimes it's very complex. Catholicism is simple and complex because God is simple and complex. I exhort you to reject a notion that the Faith is supposed to be either/or; for true faith is both/and. (Jesus is both fully God and fully man; Salvation requires both faith and works; you are both beautiful and sinful)
