As we approach the day when our elect will be baptized, confirmed, and receive the Eucharist for the first time, we celebrate three Scrutiny Sundays. The scrutiny rites are centered on the elect, but they need to involve the wider community. Together we pray that God may help the elect discover their spiritual weaknesses and strengths, may heal



their tendencies toward sin, may protect them from temptation, and may guide them toward all that is good. We pray that God may continue to do so for the rest of us as well as we all journey together on the mission Jesus left

Today's first reading reminds us of the power of water. Without water, the Chosen People would have died of thirst in the desert. Moses brings forth water from a rock, revealing God's constant presence and care. In the story of the woman at the well in the Gospel, Jesus reveals himself as the source of living water, water that will well up in us to eternal life. After this incident, many people of that town came to believe in him. May hearing Jesus' words to the woman at the well strengthen our own faith.

When do I get the feeling that my spiritual well has run dry? How do I reinvigorate myself spiritually?

**April 18 Good Friday** is obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own *sui iuris* Church.
